Bobotie (South African dish)

- 1 cup milk
- 1 thick slice white bread
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 large onion, chopped
- 2-1/4 lb. ground beef
- 2 teaspoons apricot jam
- 1/4 cup lemon juice
- 1/2 cup raisins (muscat or similar large kind)
- 10 dried apricots, each cut into four pieces
- 2 tablespoons mild curry powder
- 12 blanched almonds, roughly chopped
- 1 teaspoon salt

Freshly ground pepper

2 eggs

Preheat oven to 350 deg.F. Put half of the milk in shallow dish, add bread and soak 5 mins.


Heat oil in flameproof dish (or fry pan). Add onion and cook, stirring occasionally, 5 mins. or until soft. Squeeze milk from bread add bread to dish with all remaining ingredients except eggs and remaining milk. Mix well, then level surface with a spoon. (If using fry pan, transfer to casserole dish first). Bake 30 mins.

Beat together remaining milk and eggs and pour over meat. Return to oven and bake20-25 mins. or until custard has set.

Makes 6-9 servings.

NOTE: This dish is particularly good served with a fruit chutney.


