## LETTER FROM VALLEYCREST

April 19, 2010

Re: Weeds in Turf

As this unusually cold winter draws to an end we find lawns not fully green and with many more weeds than we would normally see this time of year. There are several reasons for these conditions:

- Record cold weather since December with heavy frosts deep into normally frost-free South Florida has kept turf essentially dormant since mid-December. Dormant turf does not compete well against weeds, so cool season annual weeds have a growth advantage and are more plentiful than usual this time of year.
- Winters are normally pretty dry in most of Florida, but this year has been an exception. We have experienced unusually heavy rain fall (El Nino pattern), and this has provided plenty of moisture for weed seed to germinated and become established.

3. Weed control products work slower in cold weather and are not as active against hard to control weeds.

In short, we have more weeds this season than we have had in many years. Once the weeds are treated, it normally takes three to four weeks to see the full effect. We are in the process of scheduling and applying these weed control applications and should be treating weeds on your property in the next few weeks.
