

Below are listed some of the physical changes which have taken place or

will take place in the neighborhood this year:

- ✓ Gutters have been installed on the clubhouse
- ✓ Fire alarm systems upgraded and strobe light relocated to accommodate gutters
- ✓ New pump on the pool circulating system due to failure of old one
- ✓ Twelve (12) chaise lounges redone
- ✓ Fifteen (15) Washingtonian Palms trimmed
- ✓ A great deal of volunteer work devoted to cleaning, upkeep and general maintenance in the neighborhood
- ✓ Quick and timely response by our landscaper to straighten downed and leaning trees after the hurricanes, costing over \$2,000.
- ✓ Two trees removed on the south side of the pool
- ✓ New steps installed on the pool- side of the clubhouse - to be painted after sufficient drying time.
- ✓ Replacement of plantings at several home-sites
- ✓ Work remains to be done on the clubhouse front. steps, but sidewalk extension has been completed.
- ✓ Mulch will be arriving in the next 30-45 days
- ✓ Additional tree trimming to be done before year end
- ✓ Some pesky problems continue with lawns, which have been discussed at great length with the landscaping company. We ask your patience as we work with the landscaper.
- ✓ Shelves have been purchased for organization of the library.




Our Thanks to the Clean Team

You may have noticed, our clubhouse is sparkling clean.


Alarie & Jack Martin.



Tomato Tart

Compliments of Margery Arendt

This recipe is best made in a tart pan, but can be made in a traditional pie pan. Measurements are based on tart pan construction, and may need to be lessened if a pie pan is used. Also, if a pie pan method is preferred, the frozen crusts that come ready-to-bake in a disposable pie pan will save you some effort.

1 frozen pie crust, thawed.

3/4 C. shredded Monterey Jack, Swiss or Mozzarella cheese 3 or 4 (depending on size) ripe tomatoes, peeled, halved and sliced thin.

To taste: garlic salt, chives, oregano and fresh basil leaves.

Preheat oven to 375°.

Roll out pie crust and fit to tart pan. Once pressed into place, use rolling pin or knife to cut excess crust off top. (For pie pan, fold crust over top of pan and crimp edges.) Prick bottom and cover shell with foil. Bake 8-10 mins. Uncover, and bake 2 to 3 mins. more, until light brown. Allow crust to cool. Cover bottom with cheese. Top with tomatoes and sprinkle with garlic salt, chives, oregano and fresh basil. Bake 20 mins. Let stand 10 mins.
